Students are also encouraged to spend time with their teachers outside of the classroom to enhance their education and build lasting friendships.

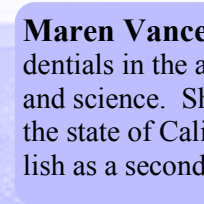


Board of Directors
